What is the event?

Which areas of the Domain and Garden are impacted by this event and when?

The event will be in the Phillip Precinct of the Domain.

Road Closures

Art Gallery Road will be closed to inbound traffic from 9 pm on Saturday 14 December 2019.

Temporary Police managed road closures to facilitate the egress of patrons from the event site will be in place from approx. 10 pm.

Some delays may be experienced during peak ingress and egress times. A vehicle drop off zone will be in place at the corner of Hospital Road and Art Gallery Road.

Footpath Closures

Phillip Path and Arbor Day walk path will be closed on event day only. Directional signage will be installed at pedestrian pathway intersections advising of alternate routes around the event site.

Parking restrictions / parking availability

Limited metered parking is available on site and at the Domain Car Park (operated by Wilson Parking). For prices visit: [Domain Car Park](#)

Mobility Pass Holder access

A dedicated event drop off zone will be operational on Saturday 15 December located on Hospital Road near the corner of Art Gallery Road. Parking is available at Domain car park with lift access to the Crescent precinct which is adjacent to the event site.
