

Event FAQs for Step Up ! for Down syndrome 2019

What is the event?

The Step UP! for Down syndrome will be held in The Domain's Phillip Precinct on Sunday 29 September 2019 with 200 participants expected to attend.

The whole community is invited to participate in the 2.5km walk which will begin at 10:30am and take in the lovely scenery of the Royal Botanic Garden Sydney. After the walk enjoy refreshments and entertainment.

This year the event is also supported by the Law Enforcement Torch Run with 20 off duty Police Officers running side by side carrying a torch. Run will commence at Queen Elisabeth II Gates along Farm Cove seawall path, Mrs Macquaries and Art Gallery Road and into the Domain where a small caldron will be lit signifying the start of the Step UP! for Down syndrome walk.

The annual event brings people together to raise funds and celebrate the achievements of people living with Down syndrome.

Which areas of the Domain will be impacted by this event and when?

The Step Up! for Down syndrome event site will be located in Phillip Precinct, the Domain with a 2.5 km walk on pathways along Art Gallery Road, Mrs Macquaries Road and Royal Botanic Garden.

Pedestrian access will be maintained on pathways. Bump in will commence Sunday 29 September morning and conclude on Sunday 29 September afternoon.

I am not attending the event, will I still be able to access the Garden and Domain on the event day/s?

Yes, pedestrian access to the Royal Botanic Garden Sydney and Domain will be maintained at all times.

What will the traffic and access impacts be?

There are no road closures for this event as walkers will use existing pathways.

Will The Terrace Pavilion / Botanic House Restaurant be open as usual?

Yes, both venues will open as usual.

Will the Garden Shop still be operating?

Yes.

Will the Choo Choo Express still be operating?

Yes.

Will there be any sound impacts related to this event?

A small low impact PA system will be in place with sound active from 8:45 am to 13.30 pm.
