Accessibility & Inclusion

The Royal Botanic Garden and Domain Trust provide accessible options to create a safe, inclusive and enjoyable event for all.

Midnight at the Oasis is ticketed event located on the waterside of the Botanic Garden with panoramic views of the Sydney Opera House and Sydney Harbour Bridge.

Site Description

- The event site is approximately 900 metres or a 15-minute walk from the entry gate on Art Gallery Road
- Please understand that the site is in the open overlooking Sydney Harbour and as such the area has no shade or cover. Please be prepared for all weather conditions, bring a hat, sunscreen, raincoat, umbrella (small personal size only) or spray jacket
- There are accessible toilet facilities
- There is onsite security and first aid
- Pathways are sealed and there is a moderate slope to negotiate.
- The restaurant for food collection and main bar is accessible via lift
- The satellite bar is ground level and accessible via a wheelchair
- The dancefloor is raised off the ground and accessed via stairs
- There is low level, but adequate lighting

Booking a Buggy Transfer

Site Entry information

- Entry is via Art Gallery Road. There is no access through the Royal Botanic Garden
- Access is from 6.30pm
- You will be asked to show your event ticket in exchange for a wristband

Getting to the Event Entrance

- Public transport is the best way to get around on New Year's Eve
- From Martin Place station, its 1km to the entry gate. There is a lift between Philip and Macquarie Streets at the Station
- From St James Station, it is 900m to the entry gate. There is a lift at the Elizabeth St entrance at Hyde Park
- At Circular Quay station, trains will not stop between 6pm and 1am
- Driving is not recommended. The nearest public car park is at The Domain. Its open until 3am on the night. Bookings are essential. The car park has 2 lifts. Use the lift closest to the Art Gallery of NSW. It's about 240m to the entry gate.
- Vehicle clearance height in the car park is low at 1.9m

- There are no drop-off zones with road closures in place from 5am
